


## Speaking of important dates, now is the time to check your voter registration.

The **Nov. 4** election is less than two weeks away – and while all states cast their ballots on the same day, registration deadlines vary by state.



In **New York**, for example, the registration deadline is **10 days** before Election Day – but in **Pennsylvania**, it's **15 days** before Election Day.

**ICYMI: The Voting Accessibility Act turns 40!** 

Here's one milestone you may have missed last month: on **Sept. 28, 2025**, the nation marked the **40th anniversary** of the **Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act**.

Passed in 1984, this law required that every polling place in federal elections be accessible to older adults and people with disabilities – and if no accessible location was available, an alternative voting option had to be provided.

The Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act required states to take certain steps to make the voting process accessible to people with disabilities.

This law was a crucial step towards making democracy more inclusive – especially for the 61 million Americans living with a disability, the largest minority group in the United States.

### But the fight for equitable and accessible healthcare continues – so join our webinar on Nov. 6!

H.R.1 is the biggest cut to healthcare in U.S. history. The result: higher costs, worse coverage, strained care systems, and a public health crisis in the making. Between gutting Medicaid, CHIP, and ACA cuts, H.R. 1 kicks 15 million Americans off of their health insurance and more than doubles premium costs for 22 million people.


